I accept personal checks, credit cards, cash, travelers checks or money orders (5% added for credit card payments), all hunt prices are also subject to 5% tax/fee.

- * Deposits must accompany your reservation and are non-refundable.
- * Final Payment required 30 days prior to the hunt starting date.

REFUND POLICY

* If you cancel your regular scheduled hunt, I will transfer your deposit to next year IF another replacement hunter is found and all fees are paid, otherwise, all deposits are non-refundable. Antelope, Moose, Sheep, Goat and Lion hunt deposits (drawing) will be transferred to next year or applied to a different hunt, if not successful in drawing.

TAG COSTS, MOTEL AND FOOD ARE CLIENTS RESPONSIBILITY

Plan on arriving in the afternoon the day prior to the date your hunt is scheduled in either Missoula or Hamilton, Mt. If you fly into Missoula, we will pick you up or you may rent a car at the airport and drive to Hamilton, you may wish to sight in if necessary. 50.00 airport pickup and return charge.

SUGGESTED Supply list (What To Bring)

- 1. Fleece, water resistant pants or wool pants, both lightweight and heavy. Fleece and wool is highly recommended as they shed water and are also the quietest while hunting. Down or nylon clothing are noisy for hunting. Please, no poncho type rain wear.
- 2. Fleece or water resistant jacket or wool. Breathable shirts, both lightweight and heavy. Warm underclothing and plenty of socks, both wool and lightweight. Gaitors are nice to have in deep snow.
- 3. Toilet kit and personal items. Comfortable pants, shirts and jacket for evening. (Motel)
- 4. Cold and wet weather boots. There are a number of good boots on the market today. We have found that waterproof, insulated, Vibram soled leather boots work well and also rubber-bottomed, leather-topped, insulated pack boots with Vibram or Airbob soles. Vasque, Crispi, LaCrosse, Timberland, Browning, are all good and have excellent traction, which is a must for rough country.

- 5. Daypack, to carry camera, lunch and small items, gloves, hat, Flashlight, binoculars, match case and knife (extra batteries for flashlight). Extra Jacket.
- 6. Two boxes of ammo should be sufficient. (check your rifle here prior to hunting). We do not recommend bronze, silvertip or hollow point bullets.
- 7. A hunter orange vest is required in Montana and must be 400 square inches. This can be a vest, shirt or jacket that you wear on the outside, above the waist during rifle seasons. Be sure it is quiet material, it may be camo orange. If you have any trouble getting the above items, check with Cabella's or please get in touch with me and I can suggest where to buy them. Our experience in clothing and hunting gear will help you have a successful hunt!

You may apply on the internet @ www.fwp.mt.gov FOR ALL TAGS. We are Permitted on over a million mountain acres, including areas: 204, 240, 250, 260, 261, 270 and area 700.

The beautiful Bitterroot and Sapphire Mountains with their majestic peaks are home to trophy size Big Game. Our Montana areas for hunting are on the Bitterroot National Forests of western Montana. Hunting access to areas is primarily by 4×4 vehicle on mountain logging roads. Most hunting is done on foot, since there are many remote roadless areas available.

Guides try to hunt places with little or no hunting pressure from other hunters. Professional Guides are licensed and trained in calling, stalking, tracking, capeing, skinning and will get your game to a processor or cold storage.

All you need is personal gear, food, LODGING, weapon, license and tags. Lodging AT A NICE MOTEL, with DISCOUNT and full breakfast included, only \$79.00 per night! We have restaurants and 24 hour grocery stores nearby.

We recommend you sight your rifle in at 2" high at 100 yards.
